NEW PROJECTS

EDUCATION

• **ADOPTION OF 9 GOVT. SCHOOLS IN MAGADITALUK, RAMANAGAR DIST**

JSSF adopted 9 Govt aided schools on experimental basis. All these schools impart education in Kannada medium and established more than 2 decades ago by Sri Siddaganga Mutt, Tumkur. Over the years due to influence of English medium schools affluent families have opted out of these schools and now children from less privileged section study in these schools.

JSSF intend to bring quality education to the poor for free. We have initiated many programs to motivate the teaching community and the students.

• **E-LEARNING PROJECT:** Aims to provide fun learning medium that enables a student to understand the curriculum through audio visual modules, which holds the interest of the learner for longer duration. The E-Learning Centres will have:

- **A Projector or 40" LCD television and Solar enabled Power pack set.**
 - **High quality software in local languages with state approved curriculum for Class VIII, IX & X.**
- Partner organisation **Rotary club of Cubbon Park, Bengaluru.**

• **COMPUTER EDUCATION:** Provided 3 desktop computers to each of the 9 High schools and a part time teacher recruited to impart basic knowledge in computer science. Even though these schools are just 50 kms away from IT capital Bengaluru, the students got the opportunity for the first time to touch the computers.

• **SPOKEN ENGLISH:** In order to improve the communicating skill JSSF has provided part time teacher for the purpose. 5 High schools are covered under the project.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

- ❖ 3 days residential Personality Development Camp conducted for the students on 10-12 of July 2015 in which 53 students and 9 teachers participated.
- ❖ Eye Check-up for all the students conducted in each of the adopted school. In total 1053 students screened and 112 spectacles were distributed. Further 53 students were provided further treatment at Vittala International Institute of Ophthalmology.
- ❖ Exposure trip to Krishi Vigyana Kendra was organised for the benefit of students and parents of Bylakere village
- ❖ Regularly publishing Monthly newsletter for the benefit of students community since September 2015.

COMPUTER BLOCK AT SVYASA, JIGANI, BENGALURU

The newly constructed Computer Block- JAI SHIVSHAKTI GANAKA VIBHAG- have 60 computers with necessary software for the benefit of the students who are studying in different courses in this prestigious deemed University. It also computerise the whole operation of Arogyadhama which in turn helps research work in the field of YOGA

S-VYASA (Swami Vivekananda Yoga Anusandhana Samsthana) has successfully worked on the two Yoga fields' viz., Yoga research and Yoga therapy and has poured life into it. It has substantiating scientific validation through research by establishing Anveshana, a state-of-the-art Research Centre within the campus. More than 300 research papers have been published and indexed in Pub Med/Medline or Psychlit/Psychinfo (UK & USA journals). The University has got status of Centre of Advanced Research (CAR) in Yoga and Neurophysiology and is accredited by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)

VITTALA JAISHIVSHAKTI COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY

JSSF in association with Sri Keshava Trust which runs Vittala International Institute of Ophthalmology (pioneer in providing quality eye care to the mass) ventured into setting up VITTALA JAISHIVSHAKTI COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY in their premises at Hoskerehalli, Bengaluru. Classes are commenced from this academic year 2015-16 with 10 students for 3 years BSc (Optometry) course which will gradually increase to 30 students per batch.

HEALTH

PREVENTION, MANAGEMENT AND CURE OF THALASSEMIA IN BENGALURU

With the active support of JSSF, Sankalp India Foundation provides systematic care and management of thalassemia taking care of 480+ children from Karnataka and neighbouring states in the two thalassemia day care centers at Indira Gandhi Institute of Child Health, Jayanagar and Rastrothana Parishat, Chamrajpet, Bengaluru.

A New Bone Marrow Transplantation unit was established at Peoples Tree Hospital, Peenya, Bengaluru. This low cost BMT unit focuses towards treating thalassemia children and setup on a Not for Profit basis. This unit brings down the cost of transplantation at Rs.7.5 lakh against prevailing cost of Rs. 13-25 lakhs per surgery in other hospitals. The unit was inaugurated on 27th of August 2015.

VISION CENTRE AND COMMUNITY REHABILITATION PROJECT

Was launched on 17th of July 2015 at Nandini Layout, Bengaluru for the benefits of visually challenged people. This is a low cost model to provide eye care to the poor which can cater to the population of one lakh. This project is managed by Vittala International Institute of Ophthalmology and guided by Operation Eyesight Universal, Canada.

UPLIFTMENT

• ECONOMIC EMPOWEREMENT OF NAINAR KUPPAM FISHING HAMLET

Chinmaya Mission, Chennai has adopted Nainarkuppam fishing village at Uthandi near Chennai lies in the neighbourhood of Chinmaya Tarangini Meditation Niketan. This village is over 4 centuries old, with a population of approximately 3000 people holds on to its rich traditions. The hamlet has 3 very ancient beautiful temples dedicated to the Mother Goddess to bring them back safely each day as they dare into the seas for their livelihood.

JSSF agreed to sponsor 18 boats which will transform the lives of entire population. Each boat can employ 4 male adults and the catch can employ several female (vendors). On 2nd of October 2015 boats are given in a festive atmosphere to 10 fishermen and registered in the name of their wives. 8 more boats distributed in November 2015.

• ADOPTION OF 2 VILLAGE PANCHAYATS IN CHAMBA DISTRICT, H.P:

Chinmaya Organization for Rural Development (CORD) is a National trust formed in 2003, which is working for 'Comprehensive Integrated Rural Development Work'. CORD has more than 30 years of experience in integrated rural development work. It has gradually expanded to cover more than 550 villages in rural Himachal Pradesh. These sites are remote and peak hilly areas cut off from mainstream national development in multiple ways. JSSF will support Gurar gram panchayat in Mehla block and **Bounderri** gram panchayat, Tissa block for next 5 years.

• **HOUSING FOR HIV PATIENTS AND POOR**

JSSF partnered with Rajiv Gandhi Rural Housing Corporation Ltd to provide 42 units of one BHK houses at Giddenahalli in Bengaluru urban district for HIV patients and 58 units at T.Bekuppe village in Ramnagar district for needy poor families.



UPCOMING PROJECTS

• **NISARGA GRAMA FOR STREET CHILDREN**

Sparsha Trust is a voluntary, secular and non-profit organization founded in 2005 in Bangalore to protect child's rights. Children on the street are coming from difficult backgrounds like a child labour, broken families, rag-picking or drug addiction. Sparsha wants to create a society free of exploitation of children and help them manifest their inherent potential and talents. Sparsha Trust consists of 5 centers, where those children are provided with the protection, accommodation, food and education.



The upcoming project of the trust called Nisarga Grama, a educational cum rehabilitation centre for 500 street children is under construction at Hesaraghatta, Bengaluru. JSSF is supporting the construction of 2 dormitory blocks which is expected to complete by May 2016.

ART VILLAGE

JSSF entered into MOU with Rotary Club of Indiranagar and Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan(BVB) to establish 'National School of Arts' where all the art forms will be taught to deserving students from all the sections of the society. Concept is 'Affordable Art for all'. It will come up in the prime location at the campus of Gandhi Nagar High School, Kumara Park West, Bengaluru. BVB is running Kala Bharati-A school for Visual & Performing Arts 5 year diploma course in various disciplines for the past over 2 decades and has produced more than 4000 artistes in various fields. The proposed Art village will be of world class and will be on tourist map in next 5 years

CARDIAC REHABILITATION CENTRE

JSSF joined hands with Needy Heart Foundation and Rotary Indiranagar to establish Cardiac Rehabilitation Centre at Sri Jaydeva Institute of Cordivascular Sciences and Research Hospital.
